RE: CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN LIMOUSINES

WHEREAS the government of Alberta has established in legislation , The Gaming and Liquor Act (GLA), which permits consumption of alcohol in properly permitted buses and limousines, and

WHEREAS the current Livery Transport Bylaw 6M2007 which regulates the taxi and limousine industry in Calgary has section 86(d) which prohibits the consumption of alcohol in any livery vehicle, inclusive of properly permitted buses and limousines, and

WHEREAS the Gaming and Liquor Act in section 69(1)(a) allows for municipal bylaws to be paramount to the GLA's legislation and regulations, and

WHEREAS some limousine operators in Calgary are seeking an amendment in Bylaw 6M2007 to permit consumption of alcohol in properly permitted buses and limousines, and

WHEREAS Council recently appointed the newly created Taxi and Limousine Advisory Committee on 2007 September 10,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Taxi and Limousine Advisory Committee be directed to obtain feedback from the local limousine operators and other relevant stakeholders, including City administration, and provide a recommendation back to Council on this matter.
