The Ward 13 Land Use Mobility Advisory Committee (LUMAC) was established a few years ago by Alderman Colley-Urquhart and is Chaired by Mr. Tony Cleveland. Membership is made up of representatives from the Ward 13 communities and its role is to advise Alderman Diane on Planning, Land Use and Transportation issues (existing or proposed) that may impact individual communities or Ward 13 as a whole. LUMAC also advises Alderman Diane on citywide matters such as PlanIt Calgary.

In light of a change in ownership of the Shawnee Golf Course, and Geo-Energy submitting Land Use and Outline Plan applications to the City for redevelopment of 135 acres of green space, Alderman Diane is pleased to **announce the appointment** of a LUMAC member to coordinate all aspects of this Project. Mr. **David Jacobs** has been appointed and has accepted this new volunteer role as LUMAC Golf Course Project (GCP) Coordinator. David has worked for many years as a professional in the area of land use development and acquisition, at both the City of Calgary and as a private consultant. His many years of experience and expertise will have a significant impact for our communities. David and his family are also residents of the Shawnee/Evergreen community.

As the GCP Coordinator, David will:

1. Assist LUMAC and President's Council in understanding all aspects of the Area Structure Plan (ASP) and Land Use & Outline Plan (LU/Outline Plan) Applications, and the impact on the surrounding neighbourhoods, Ward 13, and the lands south of Fish Creek Park.
2. Inform LUMAC of progress of the applications (ASP & LU/Outline Plan).
3. Identify and monitor issues that need to be addressed.
4. Work with key consultants.
5. Suggest issues that need to be pursued by the Developer/consultants and/or Administration.
6. Identify required studies and their potential impacts on the communities:
 - a. Transportation
 - b. Environmental
 - c. Open space
 - d. Engineering
 - e. Transit Oriented Development (TOD)
7. Coordinate and communicate with Alderman Diane, LUMAC, consultants, stakeholders, City Administration, and the developer.
8. Liaise closely with Alderman Colley-Urquhart and City Hall (Council and Administration).
9. Identify opportunities for comprehensive community and stakeholder consultation.
10. Assist in developing communication pieces to keep all parties apprised in a timely manner.
