## City rejects plan for RV parking

Calgary's recreational vehicle crowd won't get a break on parking during the summer months, despite a move by a local aldermen to loosen restrictions.

With homes away from home set to hit area highways with the May long weekend looming, Ald. Gord Lowe called on his council colleagues yesterday to relax the RV parking rules in residential communities during peak season.

The city's Land Use Bylaw restricts the length of time recreational vehicles can be parked on residential streets or in driveways and complaints can land those who fail to comply with fines.

Lowe suggested the city look into slackening the parking rules between May 24 and Sept. 1 to give weekend campers an opportunity to enjoy the outdoors without fearing a ticket under their windshield wipers.

But not all aldermen were on board with the scheme.

Ald. Diane Colley-Urquhart said allowing free rein for the vehicles will only lead to complaints that will land on the city's lap.
