### **RE: ENTRANCEWAY GUIDANCE FOR PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS the adoption of the Improving Calgary's Entranceways in 1994 identified significant entrances to the City of Calgary and identified possible themes within the public realm for these entrances, and

WHEREAS the public realm improvements and theme concept realized limited implementation for budget reasons, and

WHEREAS the Improving Calgary's Entranceways (1994) study did not adequately address land use and development issues for land adjacent to city entrances, and

WHEREAS the Improving Calgary's Entranceways (1994) is being updated with the "Improving Calgary's Entranceways: A Guide for Development Adjacent to Entranceways" to address land use and development issues for land adjacent to city entrances and has identified that more work may be undertaken in the public realm within entranceways should Council identify this as a priority, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Administration will provide a scope of study for developing guidelines for the public realm components of city entranceways including:

- a) the determination of priority entranceways,
- b) the timeline associated with study,
- c) a full costing of the study including budget and resource implications, both capital and operation, and
- d) the scope of study be referred for prioritization in the 2012-2014 Corporate Land Use Policy Work Program.
