TOWNHALL MEETING: TSUU T'INA LANDFILL FIRE

Calgary AB – Alderman Diane Colley-Urquhart is hosting a townhall meeting at the Woodcreek Community Centre on February 21st from 7:30-9:30pm to hear from residents affected by the landfill fire that occurred on the Tsuu T'ina lands last week.

“This townhall is about the residents that live in this area,” stated Alderman Colley-Urquhart “It’s about their health and safety, and trying to ensure that something like this does not happen again.”

Alderman Colley-Urquhart will be presenting what she has learned so far about the City’s and the Province’s response to the fire and will be asking residents who attend to share their stories on how the fire affected them.

“I have received hundreds of calls from upset residents about the fire,” said Alderman Colley-Urquhart, “I want to make sure the City, the Tsuu T’ina Nation, and the Province, are doing what they can to prevent these kinds of incidents from ever occurring.”
