Update on Development Around LRT

Adele advised that Diane had appointed David Jacobs to chair a working group to address traffic and development issues in Shawnee/Evergreen. David Jacobs will attend next LUMAC meeting to update members on this issue.

New Business:

Natural Gas Pipeline Relocation

The City of Calgary has requested the relocation of the current pipeline (which was originally constructed in 1922) so that it will not conflict with water/sanitary lines, to an alignment west of its current location under 24 Street, between 162 Avenue and Highway 22X. Residents of Bridlemeadows Manor will be notified of project and work schedule. Construction is expected to begin the last week of May/first week of June. A detour will be required for 2 days when the tie in is done at the end of the project. ATCO will be removing the old pipeline once it is decommissioned from under 24 Street in addition to an abandoned Conoco Philips pipeline that runs alongside it – working with the City to coordinate.
